- Noah was raised in Royal, Arkansas, a town of less than five thousand people but "a million churches," as he puts it. Like many of his music icons, he grew up singing in church and loved every minute of it. He didn't like the religious aspects, but did enjoy the ability to sing for others, which was an invaluable experience. As a closeted gay man in a rural town, it was tough fitting in, and Noah always knew there was a bigger and better world out there for him.
- Noah left Royal and headed to Los Angeles after high school, where doors immediately started opening up for him. He came out and started living as his authentic self, which helped him musically. He now intentionally records songs using he/him pronouns to ensure people know who he is talking about in his music. Noah was able to release his first album "F*ck Flowers" in October 2021. It peaked at #3 on the iTunes Pop Chart and currently has a collective 5 million streams on Spotify. He also had two songs from the album chart in the Top 100 US Pop Singles on iTunes as well.
- Noah initially joined TikTok as a way to promote his album, but it took off quicker than he realized it would. He has 627K followers, 11 million likes and 35 million views on his original music alone. As one of the top independent "queer musical artists" on TikTok, Noah loves singing pop and has even dabbled in rap, as well as other genres.
- Noah has achieved success in ways many artists only dream of, but still hasn't achieved recognition he believes he is due. For him, this is the perfect opportunity to not only showcase the skills he knows he has, but to have his voice reach an even wider audience. Noah wants to become a household name, and show people that he's not just a TikTok artist.
