- Lexie grew up in a country music family, so it was almost predetermined that she'd be a country singer one day. When her family wasn't listening to country, they were singing and playing it – in fact, Lexie's first live performances were with her brother in a local band. At 13-years-old, she started a YouTube channel dedicated to her own music. Within a couple years, she released her debut EP at 16-years-old. Lexie promised herself that as soon as she was ready, she would move to Nashville... and that's where she's been for the past 6 years.
- She joined TikTok at the onset of the pandemic to expand the reach of her music, and quickly began racking up followers. She works three jobs to pay the bills – she's a nanny, a dog sitter and a dog walker. When she's not working, she somehow finds time to write new songs and play gigs all over Nashville.
- Currently at 62K followers on TikTok, she has posted several videos that have amassed hundreds of thousands of views. She has two EP's across all streaming platforms and is always working on new music. She has been dropping music on streaming platforms since 2013. Four of her songs have even appeared on national radio, thanks to some local Nashville radio shows. Lexie has also opened for country artist, Phil Vassar, multiple times. In January, Lexie will be releasing a new song with country artist, Priscilla Block, and it will be released through Priscilla's label, Universal Music.
- Lexie knows that it's hard for a woman to break into the country music scene, but that has never stopped her from trying. Similar to her biggest musical influence, Kacey Musgraves, she's ready to continue blazing the trail for women in country music. She ultimately aspires to show her friends and family that all those hours dedicated to her musical craft will have been worth it in the end.
